From the M6

NORTHBOUND: At junction 31A, take the B6242 exit to Preston(E)/Longridge At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto B6242 When the road ends, take the roundabout right onto B6241 At the roundabout, exit right towards ASDA, you will see EKM on your left. Turn left onto Caxton Road, EKM is the first drive on the left. SOUTHBOUND: Use Junction 32 onto M55 and follow the directions below.

From the M55

At Junction 1, take the A6 exit towards Preston/Garstang. Take the first left onto Eastway/B6241. At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit, turning right to stay on Eastway/B6241. Continue on Eastway/B6241through the next 3 roundabouts. At the 4th roundabout, exit left towards ASDA, you will see EKM on your left. Turn left onto Caxton Road, EKM is the first drive on the left.
